

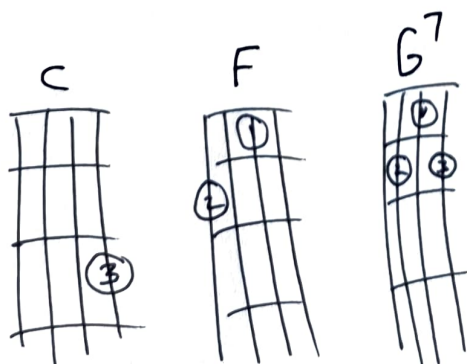
Jingle Bells
